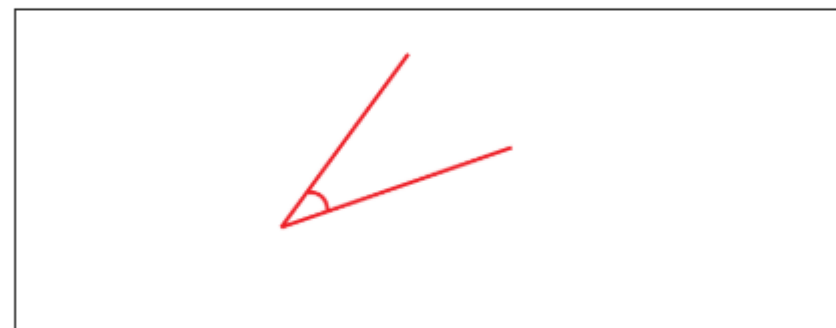

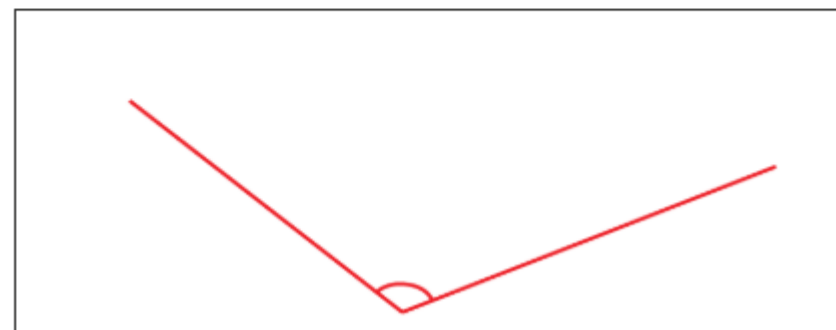
- 4 The figure below shows two lines forming an angle.

- (b) Draw two lines to make an angle larger than the angle shown above. Mark the angle.

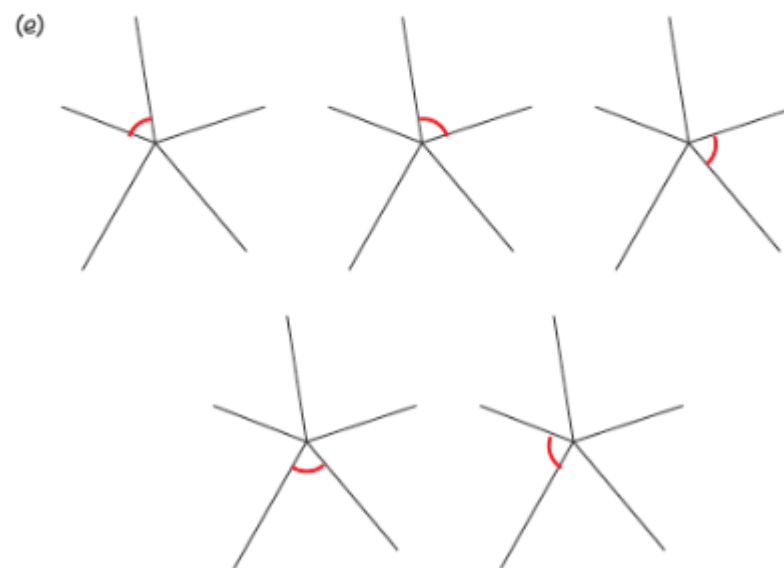
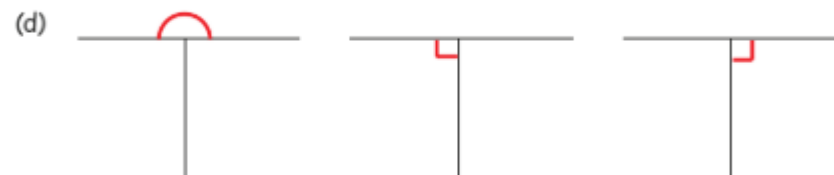
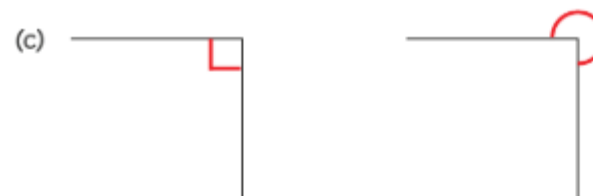
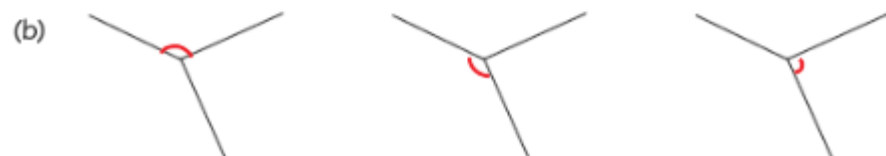
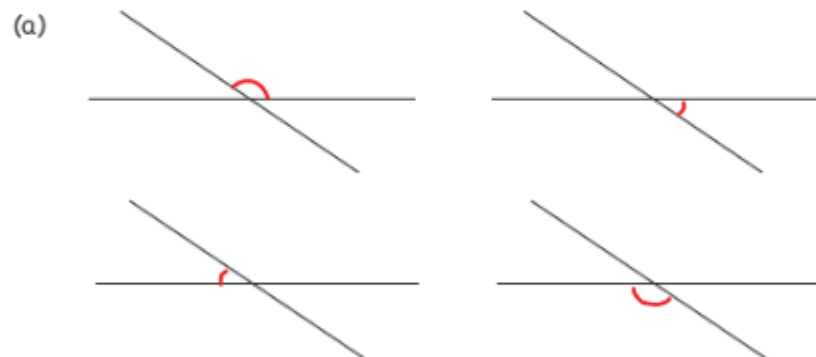
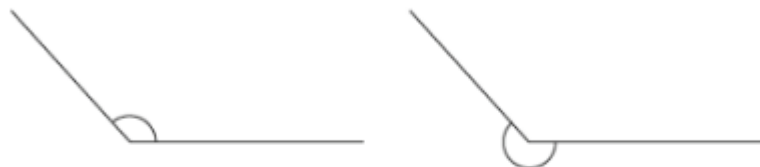
